Elvira to Morena Double Track Project

Bridge Construction

Starting this fall, crews will begin work within the railroad right-of-way, northeast of Santa Fe Street (north and south of Jutland Drive) to begin construction of new bridges in support of the Elvira to Morena Double Track project. The majority of work will be conducted away from the roadway. Santa Fe Street and the Rose Creek Bike Path will remain open at all times. Truck traffic may be increased in the area during this time. Intermittent flagging will be in place at each work site when truck traffic is increased.

Major construction activities include:

- · Potholing, trenching, and excavations
- Demolition of existing structures
- · Construction of retaining walls and bridge structures
- · Installation of signal systems and drainage improvements
- Utility relocation

Schedule

Construction activities are anticipated to begin this fall and be ongoing for the next several years. Some 24-hour work windows are required to complete this work. The first series of these work windows is tentatively scheduled for October 8-9, 15-16, and 22-23, 2016.

Work Hours

Work hours are Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. with the exception of the 24-hour work windows.
