

Have you ever taken a drink of water at a public water fountain, on a hot summer summer day, and wondered how the water got there? Well, if you are like most people, you probably have not spent too much time on this question once you have quenched your thirst. On the Mid-Coast Transit Corridor Project, that very question, however, can be answered by Paradigm Mechanical Corp. (Paradigm), a DBE certified mechanical contractor. It is Paradigm's job to install the intricate piping and ductwork that provide water, heating/ventilation/cooling and sanitation for the project.

The below images show a glimpse of Paradigm's efforts at the future Pepper Canyon Station, overlooking the University of California San Diego (UCSD) campus. With the help of torches, cutters, drills and a little elbow grease, Paradigm construction crews were able to install the various elements needed to complete the plumbing systems for the station.

Now that we have shown you what lies beneath the station platform, you will now be able to answer the question "how the water got there" when you take a drink from the Pepper Canyon Station water fountain...in 2021.
