Upcoming Project Activities

Starting February 2016, crews will begin preliminary work to clear vegetation in advance of major construction of the Mid-Coast Trolley project, in and immediately adjacent to the railroad right-of-way from Balboa Avenue to La Jolla Colony Drive.

Major activities include:

- Clearing vegetation in and adjacent to the railroad corridor
- Crews will work to minimize the impact of any noise to neighbors and businesses as much as possible

Access to nearby businesses will be maintained at all times.

Schedule

Vegetation clearing work is expected to begin in February 2016 and end in spring 2016.

Work Hours

Due to the location and nature of the work, some weekend work may be required. Work hours are Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from the Old Town Transit Station to the University City community, serving major activity centers such as Old Town, the University of California, San Diego (UCSD), and Westfield UTC. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work will begin in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in 2021.
